Adams County will host an Electronic Recycling Event and Planet Party on Thursday, April 16, 2015, 4–8 p.m., at the Adams County Fairgrounds, 9755 Henderson Rd., Brighton. Bring in your unwanted electronics, explore the eco-friendly market with your family, learn about new earth-friendly products and services, and enjoy happy hour with several local food truck vendors. Electronic Recyclers International will be responsible for collecting all electronic items. Citizens may drop off a number of electronic items at the event, such as cell phones, laptops, disk and floppy drives, test equipment, modems, circuit boards, typewriters, cables, computer accessories, video machines, stereos, video cassette recorders (VCRs), CB radios, scanners, speakers, camcorders and cameras.

“The Planet Party is the first of its kind in Adams County, and we hope to continue this event on an annual basis,” said Julia Ferguson, sustainability coordinator. “The first 100 residents to drop off their electronic items will receive a \$5 coupon for any of the food trucks at the event. You will also be able to meet with over 30 vendors and enjoy arts and crafts with the kids,” said Ferguson.
