


1. Yard Cleanup

SWAP (CWS) is not displayed on the map because it covers the entire county. Maiker Housing Partners' HUD-VASH vouchers (PSH-V) cover the entire county except for Brighton, Aurora, and Commerce City. One of the transitional housing sites for adults in Aurora is a Safe Outdoor Space/Pallet Shelter Village.

HOMELESSNESS REDUCTION MOMENTUM

The Regional Alignment on Homelessness is an initiative to promote interest and investment in ending homelessness. Staff at Adams County have met with municipal, elected, and community leaders to discuss the first steps in the process: a data-sharing agreement.



Top Five Factors Contributing to Homelessness

Abuse or violence in home	Unable to pay rent or mortgage	Relationship problem or family breakup	Asked to leave or evicted	Lost a job and could not find work
27%	24%	23%	22%	19%

The above factors are based on a sample size of 145 unique clients entered into the Homeless Management Information System that reported primarily residing in Adams County. Respondents could check multiple boxes.
