

Proclamation

“National Disability Employment Awareness Month”

October 2022

Whereas, in October, Americans observe National Disability Employment Awareness Month by recognizing the accomplishments of the women and men with disabilities whose work helps keep the nation’s economy strong and by reaffirming the commitment to ensure equal opportunity for all citizens; and,

Whereas, it is estimated approximately 5% of the United States total workforce live with at least one disability; and,

Whereas, this effort to educate the public about issues related to disability and employment began in 1945, when Congress enacted Public Law 176, declaring the first week of October each year as National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week; and,

Whereas, in 1962, the word “physically” was removed to acknowledge the employment needs and contributions of those with all types of disabilities. Twenty-five years later, Congress then expanded the week recognition to a month and changed the name to what we know it as today; and,

Whereas, this year’s theme, “Disability: Part of the Equity Equation,” invites us to recognize that this awareness month is more than a celebration, it’s a call to action. It’s a time to recommit to the hard work of advocating for better employment opportunities and outcomes for workers with disabilities; and,

Whereas, Adams County’s employee-led A-Proud affinity group, Positivity Disability, provides a safe, and welcoming environment to foster support, awareness, education, and advocacy in and around the Disability Community.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of Commissioners, of the County of Adams, State of Colorado, proclaims October 2022 as

“National Disability Employment Awareness Month”

and encourages all residents to honor the multitudes of skills and talents of people with disabilities and the important impact that they have on our society.
