Welcome to the Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) CCCAP is a program designed to provide child care subsidies to low income families for child care during employment, job search or school/college. Access to quality child care is available and workers assist families to meet their self-sufficiency goals by providing referrals to needed support services. Applicants must be under the income guidelines and in an eligible activity to receive day care assistance:

Who's Eligible?

- · Parents who are working, or
- Parents who are searching for a job (within State established time limits), or
- Teen parents (up to age 21) in a high school diploma or GED, Certificate, or Vocational program
- Parents needing child care for up to 48 months for post-secondary education or training (up to a 1st Bachelor's Degree or less), or
- GED, ESL, or Adult Basic Education, for up to 24 months, or
- Families receiving Colorado Works/TANF that are completing countable work activities on their Individual Responsibility Agreement.
- Applicants must be residents of Adams County

ALL FAMILIES MUST BE IN ONE OF THE ABOVE LISTED ACTIVITIES AND INCOME MUST NOT EXCEED THE GROSS MONTHLY INCOMES:

Program Requirements

- Parents must continuously be in an eligible activity,
- · Parents must provide income verification before approval,
- Families that qualify must directly pay "a parental fee" to their child care provider for a portion of the total cost, and
- Eligibility for continued assistance is re-determined annually.
- Parents must cooperate with Child Support Enforcement services 30 days to file.

These are the primary factors used to determine eligibility for this program. Eligibility will be determined by Child Care Assistance Program staff when the applicant has completed an application, signed the client responsibilities agreement, learn how to use the CCAP swipe machine and provided necessary verification.
