

Documentation that may be needed for Food Assistance applications:

Identity: (only one item needed)

- Birth certificate
- Drivers license or state identification card
- Work or school identification card
- Health benefits card
- Voter registration card

Unearned Income: (all that apply to household)

- Social Security, Supplemental Security Income
- Veteran benefits (VA)
- Child Support/Alimony
- Unemployment Benefits
- Retirement

Medical Expense Deduction:

For households with elderly (age 60 or older) or disabled members only

- Billing statements
- Medicare card indicating Part "B" coverage
- Itemized medical receipts, like prescription drugs
- Repayment agreement with physician

Residency: (all utility bills available)

- Utility bills, like electric, gas, water
- Rental agreement or mortgage statement that shows your address

Earned Income: (all that apply to household)

- Pay stubs
- Verification of terminated employment
- Statement from employer with gross wages
- Income tax forms
- Self employment bookkeeping records

Immigration Status:

- Immigration or naturalization papers

Documentation that may be needed for Colorado Works applications:

Citizenship and Identity:

- Birth certificate
- Drivers license or state identification card
- Passport

Social Security Number:

- Social Security Number (SSN) or proof that You have applied for a number

Unearned Income: (all that apply to household)

- Social Security, Supplemental Security Income
- Veteran benefits (VA)
- Child Support/Alimony
- Unemployment Benefits
- Retirement
- Workman's Compensation

Immigration Status:

- Immigration or naturalization papers

Earned Income: (all that apply to household)

- Pay stubs
- Verification of terminated employment
- Statement from employer with gross wages
- Income tax forms
- Self employment bookkeeping records

Other Verifications:

- Proof of Pregnancy (if applicable)
- Court orders regarding custody of child(ren)

Residency:

- Mortgage statement
- Lease agreement (which verifies your address, lists all household members and your rent and /or utility responsibilities)

Documentation that may be needed for Family Medicaid applications:

Identity: (only one item needed)

- Original photo identification for all members 16 years old and over
- Drivers license, DMV ID card, school ID
- Affidavit will need to be filled out for children under 16 years old, available at county office
- Passport

Citizenship: (only one item needed)

- Original birth certificate for all household members
- Passport

*****Please note that the original identification and original birth certificate must be viewed by county employee for Family Medicaid applications.**

Documentation that may be needed for Adult Cash and/or Adult Medical Assistance applications

Identity/Citizenship:

- Birth certificate
- Drivers license or state identification card
- Health benefits card
- Marital Status
- Immigration or naturalization papers
- Sponsor's information (including income & Resources of sponsor)
- POA, Guardianship, Conservatorship

Residency: (all utility bills available)

- Utility bills, like electric, gas, water
- Rental agreement or mortgage statement that shows your address

Unearned Income: (all that apply to household)

- Social Security, Supplemental Security Income
- Veteran benefits (VA)
- Child Support/Alimony
- Unemployment Benefits
- Workman's Compensation
- Retirement/Pension
- Oil & Mineral Dividends
- Income from gift/loan

Earned Income: (all that apply to household)

- Pay stubs
- Verification of terminated employment
- Statement from employer with gross wages
- Income tax forms
- Self employment bookkeeping records
